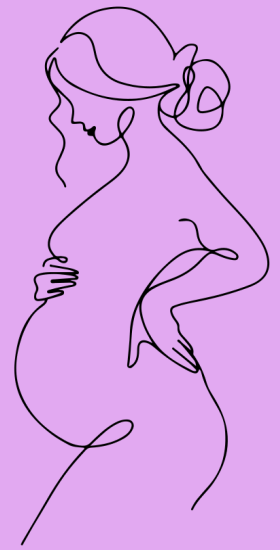

Beyond healthy births, we witnessed remarkable personal growth. These milestones reflect the deeper healing and restoration that take place when women are given stability, dignity, and hope.

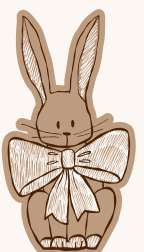
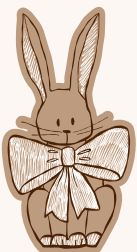
